#### **Provenance**

The various periodicals within this collection were acquired by the Sibley Music Library over a span of several years. There is no single party responsible for its donation. A few individual items within the collection bear SML accession numbers or details about the item's provenance (e.g., "8/72 Gift of Margaret Ellwanger"), but the provenance of most of the periodicals is unknown. The individual items in the collection were compiled into this synthetic collection by library staff.

#### **Scope and Content note**

This collection contains numerous music periodicals from the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. While the majority of these are American, there are also examples of German and French publications. The collection also includes some items of local interest, namely periodicals and circulars that were published and distributed in Rochester in the early 20th century.

Many of the earlier magazines are made up entirely of sheet music, revealing the popular songs and pieces of the time period. Other examples contain articles and commentary about a variety of musical subjects. Although small in size, the collection covers a wide variety of musical styles and genres.

#### **Restrictions**

There are no restrictions on the use of this collection.

#### **Associations**

The Sibley Music Library holds numerous bound serials, including additional periodicals from the 19th and early 20th centuries. Many are available in the Rare Books department, and additional bound periodicals are held in the library's serials stacks; these items can be discovered using the library's online catalog. Accordingly, additional issues of some of the periodicals contained in this collection (e.g., *The Musical Leader, The Organist's Quarterly Journal*) may be available in other locations in the library. In addition to the catalogued items, a few issues of *Musical Times*, a Rochester area periodical, are available in RTWSC's Local History File.

Many of the earliest periodicals in this collection are comprised exclusively of published music. Accordingly, the department's popular sheet music collections may also be of interest. In particular, the U.S. Sheet Music Collection contains more than 100,000 pieces of sheet music published in the United States between 1790 and 1970, including both vocal and instrumental music in a variety of genres.

## **DESCRIPTION OF SERIES**

#### **Series 1: Undersized Publications**

This series contains a wide variety of music publications, all of which are small in size (e.g., standard- or digest-sized). The group is organized alphabetically.

### **Series 2: Oversized Publications**

This series is made up of oversized musical publications which, like series one, are varied in their subject matter. These are also grouped alphabetically.
